The pupils each took part in an individual 3 minute row and a team relay. Birchensale's rowers performed admirably, with 13 out of 15 achieving personal best scores. The highest individual finishers in the boys event were 26^{m} and 27^{m} out of almost 300 entries. In the girls event the highest finishers were 84^{m} and 89^{m} from 300.

This really was a fantastic day, one which the students will remember for the rest of their lives, knowing that all the practice really did pay off!
