



Year 7 Pen Friend programme

The MFL department has set up an exciting pen friend programme for Year 7 students. We believe that this will be a wonderful opportunity for students to develop their linguistic skills and make connections with new friends.

By participating in this programme, your child will need to prepare handwritten letters to exchange with a similar age student in a school in Granada, Spain. Our students will write in Spanish to the Spanish students, and the Spanish students will then write them back in English. The students will be directed on their writing topic every time they address each other. Given that they will prepare handwritten letters, no social media will have to be shared as this will take away the exciting component to receive the letter.

The students can decorate their envelopes, create a collage envelope or be as creative as they want to be.

This could be a chance for our students to understand the Spanish culture through like-minded young people and develop Spanish in a realistic context.
