Opportunities for access

A variety of events, integrated into the school's careers programme, will offer providers an opportunity to come onto the school premises to speak to students and/or their parents/carers. We have strong links and networks with businesses and organisations and we arrange visits to the school as part of the overall careers programme.

Please speak to our Careers Leader to identify the most suitable opportunity for you.

The school will make a suitable space available for discussions between the provider and students, as appropriate to the activity. The school will also make available IT and other specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader.

Refusal for access

All requests will be given due consideration by Birchensale Middle School and the Senior Leadership team. Requests will be refused if:

- They clash with other school events such as visits, other speakers, well-being days, school photographs, sports days, public or internal exams, parents' communication events etc.
- The school is unable to provide staff to support the presentation or talk due to previous commitments
- Safeguarding reasons
- Not considered to be in the best interest of the students or is not relevant to the intended audience

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature with the Careers Leader so that they can be displayed in the Careers display at school.
